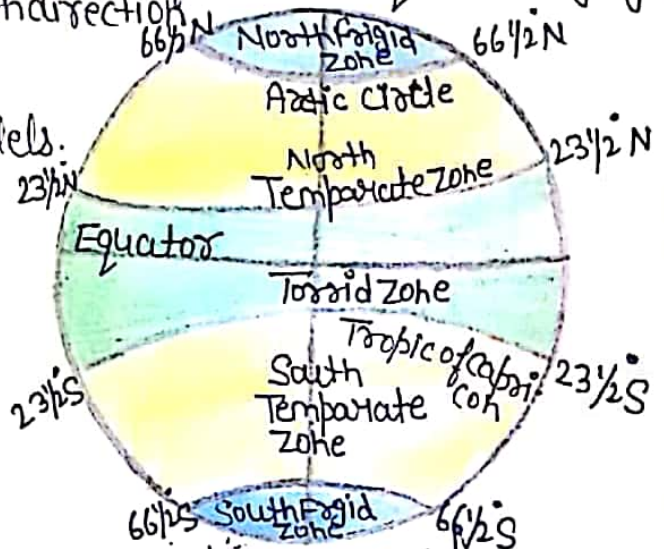
What is Latitudes?

Latitude is an angular distance of a place from the Equator laying either in the north or in the south direction.

How many important parallels?

- $23\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  S - Tropic of Capricorn
- $66\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  N - Arctic Circle
- $66\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  S - Antarctic Circle



What is a grid?

The latitudes and longitudes cross-cross each other and form a network of lines called a grid.
